Caffe Acapella's gourmet bars may look like chocolate, but they're really coffee — coffee you can eat.

They were invented by a Chester County company that found a way to take fresh roasted coffee beans and turn them into solid confections that melt in your mouth like chocolate. The bars come in flavors inspired by coffee drinks: Espresso Serenade, Toffee Espresso Concerto, Cappuccino Connoisseur and Caramel Macchiato Classico.
